Such telecommunications events do not, unlike other kinds of artwork, originate from a solitary artist but grow from what Roy Ascott calls a "dispersed authorship". Such authorship is only possible through the use of „interactive“ systems — as opposed to centralised distribution systems like television or teletext — and it is these accessible, interactive systems with which this book is concerned.
